Meet our new staff member

Jozlyn Lundy started as a camper at Camp Good News® approximately 10 years ago. She has been involved with CEF® ministry for over 6 years now. When she aged out of Camp Good News, Jozlyn pursued summer ministry with CEF as a CYIA® student. Jozlyn has served five years as a CYIA student and last year she served as a CYIA intern. Jozlyn is also currently serving in her fifth year as a Good News Club® teacher.



In the last couple years, Jozlyn has felt a call into full-time ministry. With her love for children and for the ministry of CEF, it's no surprise that she was excited to join our team here at CEF Central Wyoming.

We are excited in Central Wyoming to add Jozlyn to our team. We know that this will help us to do more ministry in our chapter! Jozlyn, is only part-time currently (at just 10 hours a week.) We are hoping with the love and support of our CEF community here in Central Wyoming that we will be able to increase her hours going forward.

Here's the situation.

When we were in the process of hiring Jozlyn on as staff for CEF in Central Wyoming, we learned that Jozlyn is eligible for a grant from the International Headquarters of Child Evangelism Fellowship in Warrenton, Missouri. This grant is in place to hire additional local staff and train them to eventually become local coordinators/directors.

This is very exciting! Part of this grant will pay for Jozlyn to attend Children's Ministry Institute at CEF International Headquarters. She is enrolled to attend training this spring. She will be in Warrenton, Missouri, for three months. During this time, she will complete all the necessary classes to receive a diploma in Children's Ministry. This is all great news! Now here's "the catch". The Central Chapter will have to increase Jozlyn's hours to full-time, at minimum, during her time at CMI training in order to maximize the grant's effectiveness. We will also need to purchase another computer for our office. Jozlyn will need this computer during her time at CMI, as well as afterwards, so she can complete school and be able to perform her job tasks as a staff member in the Central Chapter.



Jozlyn also qualifies for 1/3 of her salary to be supported through the CEF International Headquarter's grant. It is a great help to her in raising support. Just like all CEF staff, we are missionaries and we raise our own support to be able to serve in the ministry of CEF. However, Jozlyn will only receive 1/3 of what her salary is since right now she is only approved to work 10 hours a week. This will not meet the goal to maximize the grant given to her. So, she will only receive a small fraction of the financial amount that is available to her.

So how can you help?

The Central Chapter at this time is unable to meet the financial requirements. We are asking for your help! Please help us purchase an additional computer and to send Jozlyn to CMI to complete her training. In order to do that, we need to raise a minimum of \$6,000 to meet this goal.
